Treasurer's Report: Sandy Baker reported a total of \$5,849.77 in the checking account. Expenses were \$500. A donation of \$1,000 was received from ChemTreat.

Website: Jeri Bennett is working to make the member directory functional. With Sharon Reck's assistance, she will update the bylaws to reflect that the club must meet only six times a year, as approved in May, 2019.

Membership Report: Melinda McCullah is collecting dues of \$50. Members should remit payment via the Members Area online or mail a check to Sandy Baker.

Harpichord: The instrument is at the Baker home. Mark Pino has reformatted the rental form into a Word document that will be updated this summer.

Outreach Committee: Annie Feigles, Rachel Harmatuk, and Claudia Libero have begun to serve as a marketing committee for FLMF. They will explore how the club can develop more online presence, develop relationships with other music organizations, and reach new teachers. There is a need to define the benefits of membership and clarify the mission statement, to show how FLMF provides opportunities for students and helps teachers grow their businesses.
